Liquid Dampcourse.

DESCRIPTION

Crommelin[®] Dampco is an additive for cement mortars that provides a permanent barrier against rising dampness caused by movement of moisture by capillary action. Where used in brick mortars and slab parging, it forms a permanent dampcourse.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- Permanent waterproof protection.
- Blocks rising damp when used in brick mortars.
- Cost effective.
- Safe and easy to use.

AREAS OF USE

Dampco is suitable for use in the following areas:

- In mortars to prevent the movement of water up a masonry wall by capillary action above the mortar level.
- Concrete slab edge parging.

PRODUCT PREPARATION

- Dampco is ready to use.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

- Use only in conditions where the application of cementitious mortars is suitable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Add 1L of Dampco per bag of cement with water into mixer.
- Always ensure that cement and sand is added in the correct proportions (no less than 1:3) and mix thoroughly.
- Add water as required to produce a working consistency.
- The use of lime is not recommended with Dampco.
- The use of air entraining agents is not recommended with Dampco.



RE-COAT/CURE TIME

- Full cure: 28 days.

COVERAGE

- Dampcourse mortars should consist of a cement mortar containing 3 parts sand to 1 part cement plus **Dampco** added at a rate of 1L per bag of cement.
- 1L will produce 30m of dampcourse.

CLEAN UP

- Clean all equipment with water before product dries.

SIZES

- Dampco is available in 4L, 10L and 20L pails.
